## Relational Habilitation Model

We launched our new trauma informed model of care - "Relational Habilitation Model" on December 12, 2016.

The social work department has launched the Journey Journals and the TIC committee has created a "Do Better Plan."

Here are some comments from staff with their feedback of the new model and how things have been going.

"I LOVE the much improved communication between departments! We are all advocates for all of our kids. What could be better than that?

"I enjoyed the training on our new approach to handling the kids behaviors and think it is spot on! My only suggestion would be to look at costs when figuring out activities."

"For the most part I think everything is going more smoothly than expected. I really like the residents having a primary assigned to them and the new way we are doing progress review (even though it's long...lol). I think more work needs to be done with the soothing plans and helping staff and residents understand how those are to be used. I continue to hear things like "I tried to use my soothing plan and they wouldn't let me." I understand things come up and they can't always watch a movie or whatever. I would hope that they would have at least one option they can do at any given time."

"The residents having a Primary Staff seems to be working really well and helps form those relationships!"






