All of the children at Home On The Range are from North Dakota. These kids have experienced trauma most people can't imagine. The boys and girls may have been sexually abused, physically and emotionally abused, or moved from place to place. Our facility now gets many of North Dakota's youth that are sex trafficking victims. As you can imagine, with trauma like this, many of our kids have a lot of healing to do.

The goal is to resolve these problems, teach appropriate coping skills, heal trauma, and do it in a matter of months. Once the children have completed their program at Home On The Range, they return to their communities and families in North Dakota. They become young adults and begin to plan their future. That future may be finishing high school and attending college, beginning a career, or starting a family of their own; but all of them will hope to become productive and responsible citizens.

The Dakota Scramble helps us to promote life changing hobbies, activities, and events for our kids. The general care rate we receive for the kids only covers the basic needs. At HOTR, we believe in going above and beyond and making true changes. So much that we do is dependent on our fundraising efforts. I will list the sponsorship opportunities below.

\$100 - Prize Sponsor: This can be as simple as a smaller donation, or some have donated items to hand out to the golfers, like backpacks or hand sanitizer, with companies' logos on it. Companies have also donated silent auction items as well. Prize sponsors will be listed on golf carts for all golfers to see.
\$500 - Hole Sponsor: A hole sponsor will have a sign at the Tee Box, be mentioned in our Ranch Hand newsletter, and be displayed on a sponsor sheet for all golfers to see. We will also mention your support on social media. The company that sponsors the hole is welcome to have a set up at the tee box for marketing. Companies can do games of chance and make it fun. We had a sponsor last year who purchased a grill and had a game of chance for golfers to win the grill. He charged golfers to play Black Jack. It ended up bringing in more money than a hole sponsor price, so that is an option as well.
\$1,000 Sponsor: This sponsorship includes a hole sponsor, prize sponsorship, and a 4-person team to golf the scramble at Bully Pulpit.
Tournament sponsor: A tournament sponsor would pay the course rental, which is between \$7,000 - \$8,000. This would be the largest sponsorship tier that has yet to be filled. For this amount of sponsorship, we would name the golf scramble after your company, for instance "Your Company Name Dakota Scramble for Home On The Range." We, of course, would work with a company that wants to be a sponsor, if that price is too high. This would include a large banner, where all golfers start at the club house; t would be on every sign-up sheet, every flyer, and every social media promotion. It would also be heard on some radio advertising.
