## Academic Year 2022-2023

This year, the school/academic year looks a little different. Some of the children attend school at the campus classroom. These classes are only 1/2 days. Both the boys and the girls attend classes in the morning, but in separate classrooms. After their lunch break, the children participate in either their therapeutic groups or are assigned to work crews.

A few of the children go to school in the nearby town of Beach. They go to school the regular scheduled school time. These children can attend classes in the day treatment program or in the regular mainstream classes.

Home On The Range also has a private G.E.D. testing site. This is easily accessible to our children who want to study, take practice tests, and eventually take their final tests towards their G.E.D. certificate. Since January 2021, 11 of our students have received their G.E.D. certificates. When they get their certificate, we have a graduation celebration at Home On The Range for them. Just like other students or graduating seniors, they get a cap and gown, have their pictures taken, and have a graduation party with cake, punch and decorations.


